❑ **Scientific Award of Environmental Agriculture**

This award is presented to scientists who conduct research in the field of Environmental Agriculture.

❑ **Technical Award of Environmental Agriculture**

This award is presented to farmers, engineers, and technicians who conduct activities related to Environmental Agriculture.

❑ **Award for Global Greening**

This award is presented to individuals and organizations engaged in greening activities.
